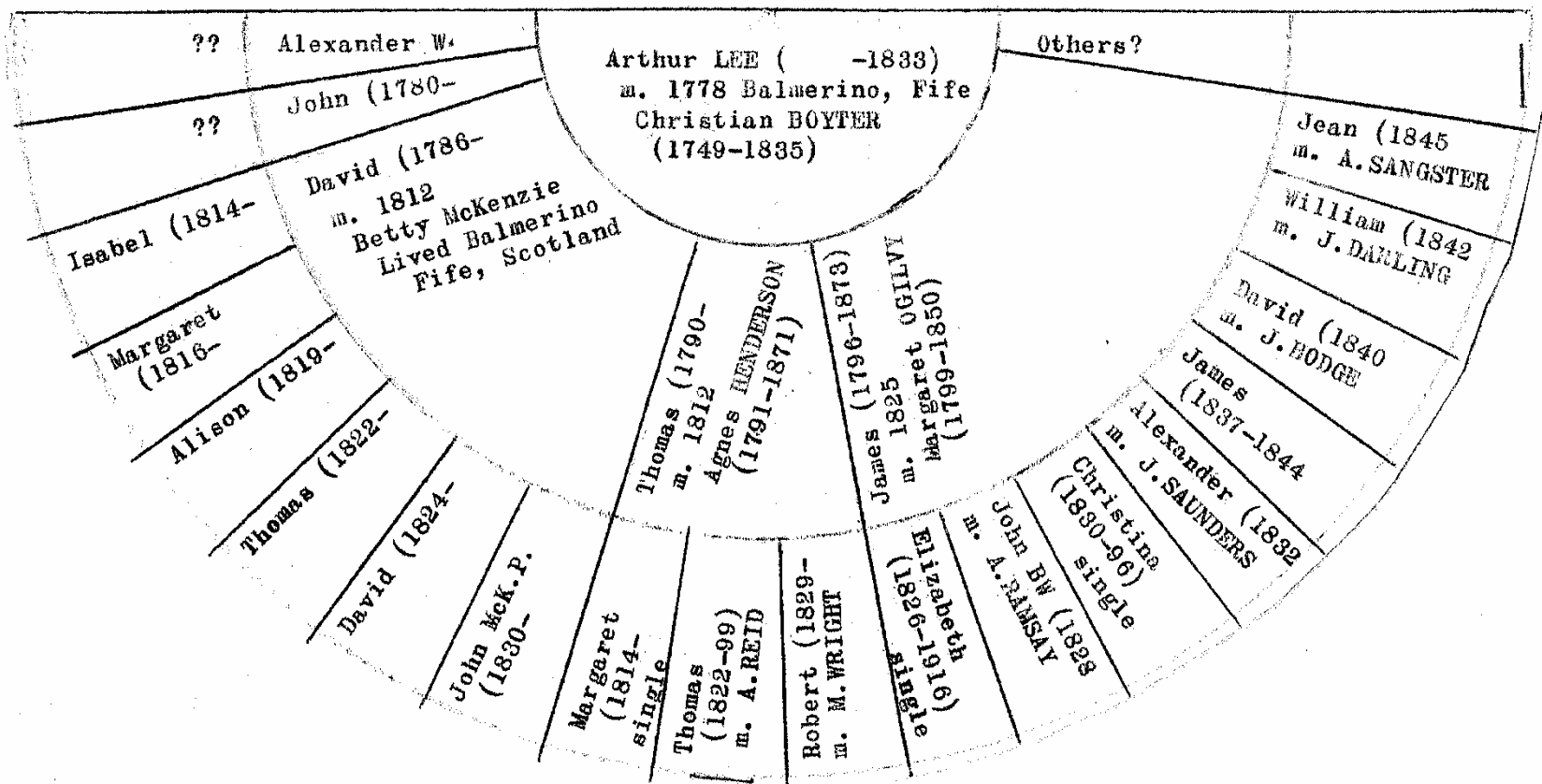

WITNESS

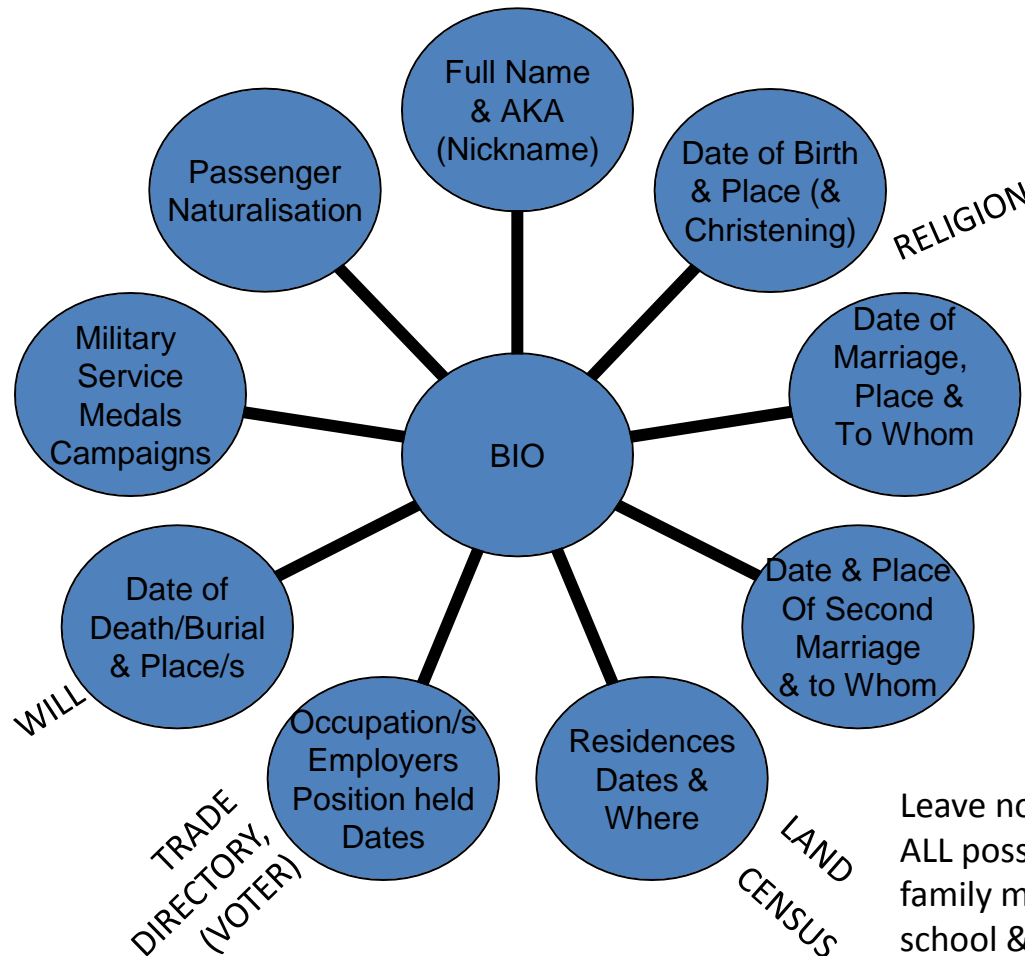
Marriage, Will, Documents

DATA TO COLLECT

A GENEALOGICAL FACT = Full name + Event + Date (in full) + Place + Relationship (to another person), e.g. Birth and Marriage Certificates³¹

GENEALOGY V PRE-WRITE 5: WOMAN'S

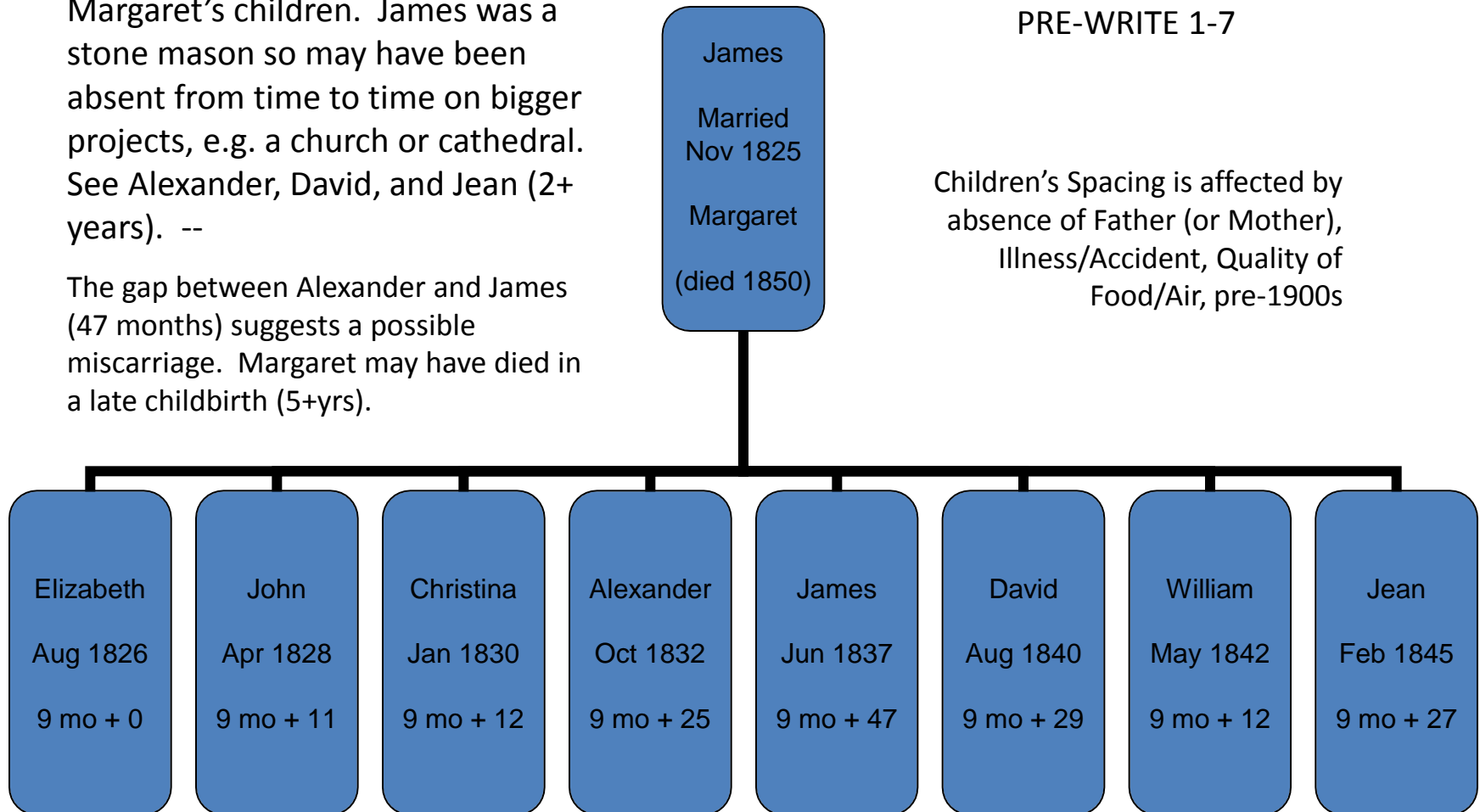
Chart to help understand each family.

This Chart²⁸ shows the spacing of Margaret's children. James was a stone mason so may have been absent from time to time on bigger projects, e.g. a church or cathedral. See Alexander, David, and Jean (2+ years). --

The gap between Alexander and James (47 months) suggests a possible miscarriage. Margaret may have died in a late childbirth (5+yrs).

<p>COMMENTS On looking at the children, Margaret had, there is a four-year gap for another child between Joanna and young Henry. Neither of the parents' deaths show a 'dead' child so either there was a stillbirth, or Henry was absent, or one of them was unwell or not able. If there had been a ?dead child it could have had the name, Peter making the pattern work at least for the boys.</p>				
<p>I have checked a few of my families of this era. Not many really have any pattern. The names in a family are repeated nevertheless so one can get a feel this is our family and that is not. Hindsight shows this rather than actively searching the other way. I prefer other methods to find an ancestry. Have developed and used Mini-One-Name Study (MONS), together with a Synthetic Family Tree, i.e. one synthesised from evidence found to be proved or eliminated.</p>
