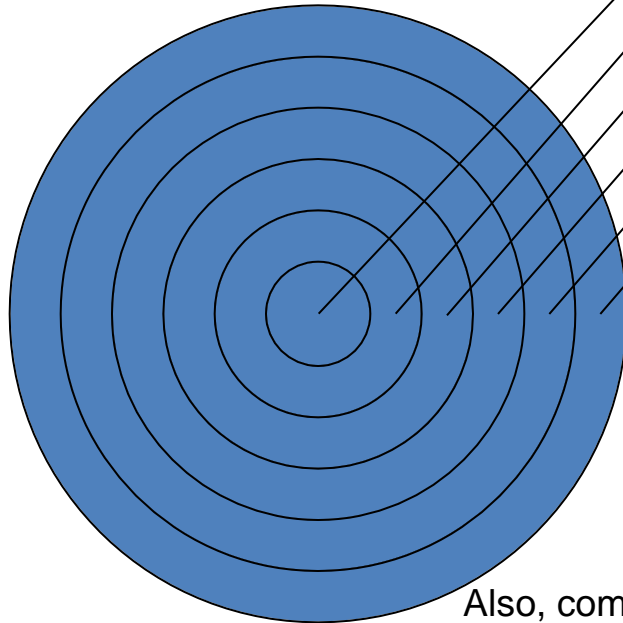

was the 'Bread Winner'

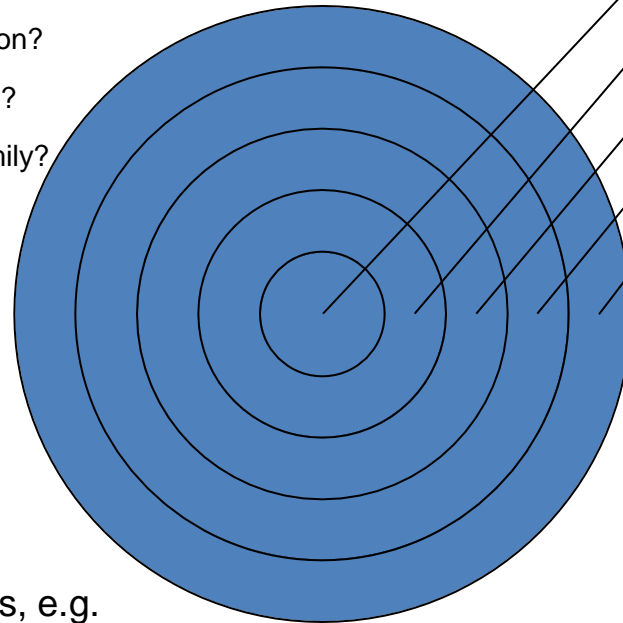


- A child's father
